66 Baker Rd – Title 5 Variance Request:

- 1) Offset to groundwater
- 2) Perc test job analysis

The applicant is requesting a variance to replace a failed septic system for a 3-bedroom home. The home is serviced by a private well located behind the home. It is an existing pipe and stone and will be replaced with an upgraded system. Due to the high water table and sandy conditions at the site, a perc test was not obtained. A sample of the sand was sent out to UMass Amherst and came back as pure sand, which is very good. The reduction of 4' to 5' will save the homeowner some money.

Jackie DeStasio made a motion to grant the variance for 66 Baker Rd. Dan Richal seconded the motion. No discussion. Charles Takesian, Jackie DeStasio, and Dan Richard voted unanimously to grant the variance for 66 Baker Rd. Vote, 3 in favor, 0 opposed. Motion passes. Variance granted.
