ACCEPTANCE OF MINUTES: Minutes for August meeting unanimously approved

HARBORMASTER'S REPORT: Received many incoming calls about moorings as Merri Mar Yacht Basin is no longer servicing mooring. Also received request to provide assistance to those providing firework display for coming weekend and HM agreed they would assist. Also received call from Newbury about Rocks Village Bridge and potential upcoming construction.

Outgoing calls included people on the waiting list for moorings. HM continues working with Mr. Santos to resolve waiting list and organizing mooring field. Collected quote from Merri Mar Yacht Basin for sandblasting and repainting Corbin.

Repowering Downwinder

1st (and only) option: 200hp Mercury Engine for Downwinder -- \$14,600, includes installation (bid from River Front Marine)

Commission Unanimously approved motion to accept bid from River Front Marine to purchase 200hp Mercury Engine for Downwinder

Hull Conditioning + Repowering Corbin

1st Option: Two 300hp Mercury Engines for Corbin; Hull Work to include blasting hull, repainting hull, re-lettering hull -- \$55,163.00 (bid by Viking Welding)

2nd Option: Two 300hp Mercury Engines for Corbin (bid by River Front Marine) + Hull Work to include blasting hull, repainting hull, re-lettering hull (bid by Merri Mar Yacht basin) – combined cost is \$53,075.50 Commission unanimously approved motion to approve bid from Viking Welding for \$55,163.00 to purchase two 300hp Mercury Engines plus Hull Work for the Corbin.

Commission unanimously approved amended motion to approve an amount not to exceed \$60,000.00 in approving bid from Viking Welding to purchase two 300hp Mercury Engines plus Hull Work for the Corbin

APPROPRIATIONS: Mr. MacLean requested a vote on purchasing and/or extending lease on storage container at MBTA lot for October meeting.

ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA: Mr. Tennis asked if there were any issues that need to be fixed on the Corbin while being serviced. HM indicated that he would review with Mr. Santos and get back to the Commission.
