Meeting Minutes April 21, 2016

The Salisbury Harbor Commission met on Thursday, April 21, 2016 at the Salisbury Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:04pm. Harbormaster's Report

Ray Pike presented the Harbormaster's Report. He reported that a Memorandum of Agreement was provided by Anna Jacques Hospital to authorize the Harbormasters to carry certain drugs on patrol.

Letters have been sent to mooring customers regarding excise taxes as well as marina customers. All users were reminded that a waterways sticker must be purchased.

Harbormaster Pike will postpone the planned expired flare shoot-off until a later date.

Old Business

It was reported that Reed's Ferry needs six weeks to provide whatever size shed is ordered.

The Commission met on March 26th to review alternative sites for the Harbormaster's office. The proposed sites were the Town Pier, the Small Boat Facility and the Salisbury Beach Reservation. No consensus was made.

New Business

Reggie Santos motioned to allocated \$2,000.00 for dumpsters to clean up the Small Boat Facility. Wayne David seconded the motion. All voted in Favor.

The Board discussed the painting of the patrol boat floor and cabin floor. The Board asked Harbormaster Pike to provide three quotes for this work.

Dave Chretien motioned to adjourn the meeting and Wayne David seconded the motion. All voted in Favor. The meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
