P & R Donation Account

Jennifer Roketenetz, newly appointed person hired to develop & grow parks & recreational programs and community events, requested to create a reserve account for the current balance of \$22, 109 to be earmarked for "Park Improvements and/or Construction." Earmarked funds may only be spent with the PRC's voted authorization. Concurrently, Roketenetz has requested to set up additional revenue and expense accounts within the fund to account for new donations and expends going forward. Ray-Parrot made a motion to create reserve account and Roketenetz the authority to oversee all future expenditures and revenue accounts

Discussion: Colburn requested Roketenetz to provide a monthly report.

New Fences at Beach Field & Lions Park

Sections of fencing at Beach Field and Lions Park are in need of replacement. Mike C. has requested estimates with vendors. No updates / awaiting quotes

Dog Park at Partridge Brook Park

Roberge to research costs for clean up of dog waste.

Roberge would like to solicit sponsors to fund clean up at the dog park. He suggested vets, groomers, kennels, etc. Roberge suggested banner or graphic wrap yearly sponsorship program. Roberge will continue to research costs..

Lion Park Tennis Court Repair

Pickleball Group power washed courts.

Lisa D was to obtain a crack & sealer estimate as an immediate improvement to court. Timmons suggested that the repairs are too significant for crack repair and the PRC should seek to repair the courts thoroughly and properly, utilizing a professional specializing in court repair.

Courts are in need of: cracks repairs resurfacing fencing

Maintenance and repair to the courts have not been done in many years. Timmons makes the recommendation to hire a consultant to analyze and create a formal report of the suggested repairs needed for the court and Lions Park as a whole.

DeMeo suggests to provide a list of what PRC sees as needed improvements and requests consultant to further note as seen

Timmons and PRC requests an evaluation and recommendations for existing conditions and for improvements.

Salisbury Days/Brewfest/Tortoise and the Hare

Tortoise and the Hare will depart from Lions park and run 100% on trails. The post run Beer Tent will be located on the basketball court. Races are a staggered start. Colburn is stationed at Bartlett Street to assist runners and provide lighting.
