Harbormaster spoke with a few people looking to fill the open Pump-out boat position.

HARBORMASTER'S REPORT:

Harbormaster is working with the Salisbury PD to get citations issued to errant boaters for last year's season.

OLD BUSINESS:

No report on an office for the Harbormaster.

MBTA lot – C. Maclean stated that a person has been hired to clean up the trees and brush remaining on the lot. Will complete in the Spring.

R. Santos suggested that the DPW do some grading on the lot after the final cleanout.

The Harbormaster reported that the storage shed would cost between \$8,000 - \$9,000. The cost of a container would be \$95 per month. C. Maclean stated that if we are looking for "dead" storage for three outboard motors and chain then we should rent the container for the equivalent of 10 years rather than purchase a shed.

R. Santos reported that the new "no wake" buoys have been received and are ready to be deployed.
