Salisbury Harbor Commission Meeting Minutes August 20, 2015

A meeting of the Salisbury Harbor Commission was held on Thursday, August 20, 2015 at the Salisbury Town Hall. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 by Chairman Chris Chapman. Members present were Chris Chapman, Reggie Santos, Wayne David, Mark Audette and Ray Pike, non-voting member and Harbormaster.

The Minutes of the July 23, 2015 Meeting were unanimously approved.

Harbormaster Ray Pike presented the correspondence.

NH Marine Patrol requested a list of all NH registered boats in Salisbury and Newburyport

The Urban Harbors Institute requested that we map the harbor and provided guidelines to accomplish this task.

Harbormaster Pike recognized the passing of former Member Don Jansen and his many years of service and contributions to the Board.

Harbormaster Pike noted that Waterway Permit revenue had reached \$58,196 as of July 31, 2015 with 430 boaters paying. He will also bring a Federal Pollution Placard to the next meeting and provide details as to what size boat is required to have one posted on board.

There was no old business.

New Business. The Harbormaster boat Dusky is no longer needed for service. The Commission will determine what equipment is considered excess and will make a determination as to what to do with it. Options are to have an auction or to donate it to towns that may need the equipment.
