We are very grateful and fortunate to be working in cooperation with Our Neighbors Table to offer free grocery delivery to those in need provided you schedule with the Salisbury Senior Center in advance. Call in your request by 3pm on Mondays we will make every attempt to deliver to you by Wednesday, based upon demand. There will be no transport charge for medication, food, or essential items delivered to those sixty and older in need by the Salisbury Council on Aging.

Medical equipment such as walkers, canes, wheelchairs, or commodes are also available for delivery or pickup, please call us to make arrangements. We continue to make daily wellness checks and have matched up our volunteers to those who would like a friendly conversation via telephone. Although the library is closed to the general public, seniors who are in need of new books can call the library, and the Council on Aging will make arrangements to deliver. If you or someone you know is in need of services, food, or general assistance please reach out to us; we will continue to serve the seniors of our community.
