

**WARRANT FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 17, 2021
SALISBURY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

TO: Timothy Hunter, Constable of Salisbury

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Salisbury who are legally qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Salisbury Elementary School, 100 Lafayette Road, Salisbury, Massachusetts, on Monday, May 17, 2021, at 7:00 P.M., to then and there act on the Articles in this Warrant.

ARTICLE ONE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$100,000.00 from Free Cash to the Stabilization Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWO

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Free Cash to the Compensated Absences Reserve Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE THREE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Free Cash to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FOUR

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from Free Cash to the Unemployment Compensation Fund to provide for unanticipated costs of funding reimbursements to the Commonwealth for unemployment compensation benefits under the provisions of MGL Chapter 151A; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FIVE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE SIX

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$25,000.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to the Compensated Absences Reserve Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE SEVEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$40,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line 0100.0220.5850 (Fire Department – Vehicles) for the purpose of purchasing and equipping a new command vehicle for emergency response for the Fire Department, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE EIGHT

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$62,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line 0100.0210.5850 (Police Department – Vehicles) for the purpose of purchasing and equipping a new administrative vehicle for the Police Department, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE NINE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$40,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line item number 0100.0541.5820 (Council on Aging – Capital Outlay -- Buildings) for the purpose of replacing the roof on the William Hilton Senior Center, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$65,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line item number 0100.0413.5850 (DPW – Capital Outlay - Vehicles) for the purpose of purchasing and installing a new packer on the rear of the Town's trash truck, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE ELEVEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line item number 0100.0413.5440 (DPW – Buildings/Ground Supplies) for the purpose of purchasing new holiday lights for the Town Common, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWELVE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line item number 0101.0123.5305.3066 (Town Manager – USACE Piscataqua Sand) to be used toward the Town's share of the cost of acquiring sand from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' dredging of the Piscataqua River for placement on or near Salisbury Beach; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE THIRTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$20,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line item number 0100.0491.5841 (Cemeteries – Capital Outlay – Site Improvements) for the purpose of repairing walls at Long Hill Cemetery and the Colonial Burial Ground, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FOURTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$20,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2021 budget line item number 0100.0123.5305 (Town Manager – Purchase of Services – Consulting Fees) for the purpose of retaining a consultant to provide professional services to assist the Town in remaining compliant with the Community Rating System program of the National Flood Insurance Program; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FIFTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$118,323.09 from the PEG Access and Cable Related special revenue fund to support the provision of public, education and governmental access cable television services. This amount represents 100% of Comcast's Franchise Fee payments to the Town for July - December 2020 per section 7.2 of the Town's Cable TV Renewal License contract; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE SIXTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2021 Water Enterprise Fund budget line item number 7000.0450.5305 (Purchase of Services – Consulting Fees) for the purpose of hiring a consultant to prepare a Risk and Resilience Assessment and an Emergency Response Plan for the Town's water system for submittal to the EPA, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE SEVENTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$15,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2021 Water Enterprise Fund budget line item number 7000.0450.5278 Capital Outlay – Infrastructure) for the purpose of upgrading the Town's water interconnection system with the City of Amesbury, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE EIGHTEEN

To take any other action that may be lawfully taken at this meeting.

And you are hereby directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies in at least ten (10) public places in Town over two consecutive Sundays before the time of said meeting.

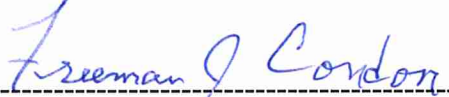
Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk at the time and place of said meeting.

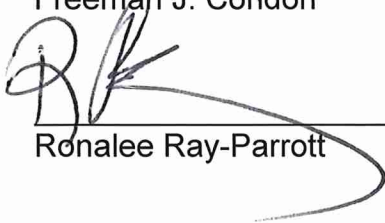

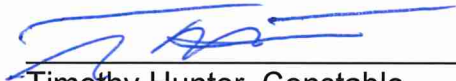
