Election Workers

Workers will have facial coverings and be seated 6 ft. apart.

Secretary of State's office allowed reduced staffing so 1 staff at check in and 1 staff at check out.

Voters

Requested to wear facial coverings

Maintain 6 ft. social distancing

There will only be 8 voting booths in each precinct and we will only allow a voter in every other booth which means there will be a maximum of 4 voters at any given time per precinct.

Booths will be sanitized after each use

Disposable ballot markers

Voters will enter through the main entrance and exit through the side door.
