Dear Homeowner:

The Department of Public Works was successful in receiving town meeting funds to upgrade the water main on Adams, Taft, and Garfield Streets. In September, through a public bidding process in which we received several bids, J.P. Cardillo & Son was awarded the contract for this project. Millennium Engineering Inc. will provide engineering construction oversight.

The proposed water main work will involve the removal and replacement of the current water main providing service to all the properties along Adams, Garfield and Taft Streets. In order to replace the water main, a temporary water main will need to be installed above ground to continue providing service to all the houses while the current water main is removed and replaced. The temporary water main will be located along the edge of the Right of Way, for the most part, and will include stone ramps to allow cars access to driveways. The temporary water main will vary in size from 2-inches to 6-inches in diameter. Rubber hoses will be installed from the temporary water main to all the houses. These hoses will provide water service to all the houses along the project streets. The hoses will be connected to your outside faucets, in most instances, and your water meter will be shut down while the new water main is installed. Access to your basement will be required to shut down and later turn on your water meter.

Once the new water main and new underground services within the public Right-of-Way are installed and tested the temporary water main and rubber hoses will be removed. The stone ramps will be removed and your water meter will be put back in service. At this point the new water main and new services will be providing water to the residents.

Construction is scheduled to start on or about October 15th, Adams, Taft, and Garfield Streets will be open to local traffic only. The project schedule will be posted on the Town's website www.salisburyma.gov
