

**WARRANT FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING  
MAY 15, 2023  
SALISBURY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

TO: Jeremy Kelley, Constable of Salisbury

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the Commonwealth, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Salisbury who are legally qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Salisbury Elementary School, 100 Lafayette Road, Salisbury, Massachusetts, on Monday, May 15, 2023, at 7:00 P.M., to then and there act on the Articles in this Warrant.

**ARTICLE ONE**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Free Cash to the Capital Stabilization Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

**ARTICLE TWO**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$70,000.00 from Free Cash to the Compensated Absences Reserve Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

**ARTICLE THREE**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Free Cash to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

**ARTICLE FOUR**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$35,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to the Compensated Absences Reserve Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE FIVE**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$50,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE SIX**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$41,848.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Water Enterprise budget line item number 7000.0450.5898 (Capital Outlay – Water Main Replacements) for the purpose of paying retainage and other incidental and related costs associated with the replacement of water mains on Toll Road; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE SEVEN**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$1,807.40 from the Transportation Infrastructure Receipts Reserved for Appropriation Fund for the purpose of funding a portion of the cost of purchasing a hot box for the Department of Public Works, said funds to supplement the sum of \$3,750.89 previously authorized for this purpose under Article 13 of the October 26, 2020 Fall Town Meeting; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE EIGHT**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$43,500.00 from Free Cash to FY2023 budget line item number 0100.0413.5815 (DPW Capital Outlay – Equipment) for the purpose of purchasing a hot box for the Department of Public Works, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE NINE**

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate \$148,446.14 from the PEG Access and Cable Related special revenue fund to support the provision of public, education and governmental access cable television services. This amount includes \$123,446.14 from Comcast for July-December 2022 Franchise Fee payments per section 7.2 of the Comcast Cable TV Renewal License contract plus \$25,000.00 from Breezeline for Cable-Related Equipment/Facilities Funding per section 6.3 of Breezeline's Cable TV License contract; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE TEN**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$6,335.00 from Free Cash and transfer the sum of \$13,665.00 in unspent funds appropriated under Article 14 of the May 16, 2022 Special Town Meeting, for a total appropriation of \$20,000.00, to FY2023 budget line item number 0100.0220.5815 (Fire Department – Equipment) for the purpose of purchasing a thermal imaging camera for the Fire Department, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE ELEVEN**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$5,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2023 budget line item number 0100.0220.5235 (Fire Department – Vehicle Repair and Maintenance) for the purpose of performing various repairs to Fire Department vehicles, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$20,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2023 budget line item number 0100.0123.5305 (Town Manager – Consulting Fees) for the purpose of hiring a professional consultant to assist the Board of Selectmen in the search for a new Town Manager, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE THIRTEEN**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$960.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Sewer Enterprise Fund budget line item number 6000.0440.5261 (Inflow and Infiltration) for the purpose of paying an outstanding bill from a previous fiscal year; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE FOURTEEN**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$1,450.00 from Free Cash to FY2023 budget line item number 0100.0610.5275 (Library – Software Maintenance/Support) for the purpose of paying two outstanding bills from a previous fiscal year; or to take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Water Enterprise Fund budget line item number 7000.0450.5278 (Water System Repairs and Maintenance) for the purpose of maintaining the Town's water system infrastructure for the remainder of the fiscal year, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE TWENTY-TWO**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$35,600.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Water Enterprise Fund budget line item number 7000.0450.5830 (Infrastructure) for the purpose of performing a cross connection survey for the Water Division, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

**ARTICLE TWENTY-THREE**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$52,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Water Enterprise Fund budget line item number 7000.0450.5820 (Buildings) for the purpose of purchasing and installing a generator and constructing a fence at the new water trailer building, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

**ARTICLE TWENTY-FOUR**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$9,500.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Sewer Enterprise Fund budget line item number 6000.0440.5275 (Software Maintenance/Support) for the purpose of purchasing and installing a portion of a new work order system for the Department of Public Works, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

**ARTICLE TWENTY-FIVE**

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$500,000.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2023 Sewer Enterprise Fund budget line item number 6000.0440.5830 (Infrastructure), such funds to supplement appropriations approved under Article 10 of the October 22, 2018 Annual Fall Town Meeting and Article 16 of the May 20, 2019 Special Town Meeting, for the purpose of constructing a new storage facility at the Town's wastewater treatment facility, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

**ARTICLE TWENTY-SIX**

To take any other action that may be lawfully taken at this meeting.


And you are hereby directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies in at least ten (10) public places in Town over two consecutive Sundays before the time of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk at the time and place of said meeting.




