Request for Quotation – RFQ-04 Lions Park Tennis Courts Resurfacing

1. GENERAL CONDITIONS

- a. The Town of Salisbury is requesting quotes for the resurfacing of two existing tennis courts at Lions Park. Quotations shall be based on the specifications provided. However, some deviations shall be accepted if it is in the best interest of the Town. All deviations should be called out in writing and explained in details with the specifications.
- b. All debris resulting from the work herein shall be removed from the roof and property and disposed of by the Contractor.
- c. Contractor must take all necessary precautions to protect the existing area from damages during repairs. All damages caused by the contractor or their employees shall be repaired at no cost to the Town.
- d. The Town of Salisbury reserves the right to reject any and all quotations if it is in the best interest of the Town.
- e. This contract will be awarded to the lowest priced responsible and responsive bidder.
- f. Submittal of at least 2 references from projects similar in scope and size is required

2. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall be responsible to the Town or any third party for any property damage or bodily injury caused by it, any of its subcontractors, employees or agents in the performance of, or as a result of, the work under this Agreement. The Contractor and any subcontractors used hereby certify that they are insured for workers' compensation, property damage, personal and product liability. The Contractor and any subcontractor it uses shall purchase, furnish copies of, and maintain in full force and effect insurance policies, listing the Town of Salisbury as an addition insured, in the amounts here indicated.

- Pressure wash two existing tennis courts
- Fill several pre-existing puddles on the tennis courts
- Repair about 300' of structural cracks using the Riteway Crack Repair System or similar service
- Apply three (3) coats of Novacrylic playing surface to entire court surface
- Paint two sets of tennis lines sing white textured line pain per the USTA standards
- Paint 4 sets of pickleball lines yellow
- Submittal of at least 2 references for projects similar in scope and size

Additional Specifications

- The Town understands that temperatures must be in the 50's with no forecasted rain in order to complete this project.
- The Town also understands that prices may vary based on supplies and rising costs associated with COVID-19 and the timeline of this project.

Conditions

- Prevailing wage applies to this project pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30, 39M
- 50% payment bond required if contract is over \$25,000
