#### At Corner Parking

- The work at the rinse station is anticipated to start the week of November 1
- Trailers may move the week of November 1
- Painting to start October 18
- Soffit and trim work will start October 18
- Tile is shipping on October 22 and anticipated on site the start tiling the week of October 25
- Epoxy floor to start after the tile

# At Broadway Mall

- Painting will start October 25
- Plumbing and electrical rough are ongoing
- Roof detailing will start October 18 and will continue for a couple weeks
- Framing of the decking will wrap up the week of October 18
- Decking will start the week of October 25
- Siding of Broadway is anticipated to be completed to week of October 18

The bigger trailer is anticipated to be removed by the end of the month. Concrete is to be completed by mid-November.

The fencing at Broadway conflicts with Castagna's ability to install the curbing and sidewalk. Castagna will develop a sketch relocating the fence for review.

40-6	At Corner Parking, the hammer head curbing that was removed will need to be reinstalled. The pieces have been stockpiled. EJA to issue a sketch for Lisa D to review.
