

FIXTURES AND AMENITIES PROVIDED

EXISTING 14 existing toilets 3 existing urinals 4 existing sinks 0 existing

PROPOSED

- 20 toilets proposed
 - 2 urinals proposed
- 12 sinks proposed
 - 5 rinse stations proposed

The two fully accessible proposed locations provide:

- 2 unisex toilets
- 11 toilets for women; 7 toilets and 2 urinals for men
- And the ability for some facilities to be open year-round.

Welcome Center features include:

- Information and meeting point
- Raised circulation and tiered seating at the Mall
- Picnic plaza and rinse stations at the Corner
- Welcoming destinations whether approached from to or from the beach.

Project Schedule:

- Design November 2019-June 2020
- Town Meeting June 22
- Bidding July-August 2020
- Construction start after Labor Day 2020
- Substantial Completion by Memorial Day 2021
- Completion by end of June 2021

Project Cost:

- Construction cost estimate: \$3,900,000
- Soft costs \$ 860,000
 Town contingency \$ 440,000
- Total requested authorization
