Meeting Minutes March 17, 2016

The Salisbury Harbor Commission met on March 17, 2016 at the Salisbury Town Hall. Present were Tom Olsen, Reggie Santos, Wayne David, Chris Chapman and Mark Audette. Salisbury Harbormaster Ray Pike was also present. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Vice Chair Reggie Santos, announcing that Chairman Chris Chapman would be late.

Wayne David motioned and Tom Olsen seconded the motion to accept the minutes of the prior meeting. All voted in Favor.

Harbormaster Ray Pike provided his report.

- All stickers are in and they are black.
- The new engines were installed on the boat and the sea trial went well.
- It was noted that at the request of the Town Manager, the Harbormaster's Office proposed for the town pier be put on hold for the moment.

A motion was made by Reggie Santos to transfer money from the Waterways Fees account, aka Revolving Fund, in the amount of \$13,792.93 to make the final payment on the boat. Tom Olsen seconded the motion. All voted in Favor.

Reggie Santos made a motion to transfer \$14,500.00 from the Waterways Fee account into the Stabilization Fund for future needs. Wayne David seconded the motion. All voted in Favor.

Mark Audette reported that no action has yet been taken at the State level regarding the fishing pier at the Reservation according to Representative James Kelcourse. Wayne David suggested that we must have input from DCR if we are going to accomplish this.

Several residents of Ring's Island were in attendance to speak against the location of the Harbormaster's Office at the Town Pier. Since it was previously noted that the project would be put on hold, Harbormaster Pike asked for comments if any location at the Town Pier would be acceptable. There was no interest from the residents to place the Harbormaster's Office at the Town Pier. Suggestions were made to use the Ring's Island Community House currently controlled by the Fire Department or place the shed on the MBTA property on Friedenfels Road.

Wayne David motioned and Reggie Santos seconded the motion to adjourn at 7:45.
