

**WARRANT FOR THE SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
MAY 20, 2019
SALISBURY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL**

TO: Robert Roy, Constable of Salisbury

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth, you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Salisbury who are legally qualified to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Salisbury Elementary School, 100 Lafayette Road, Salisbury, Massachusetts, on Monday, May 20, 2019, at 7:00 P.M., to then and there act on the Articles in this Warrant.

ARTICLE ONE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$100,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2019 budget line item number 0100.0220.5111 (Fire Department – Firefighter Salaries) for the purpose of funding the FY2018 and FY2019 General Fund costs of a collective bargaining agreement between the Town and Salisbury Firefighters Local 4694, IAFF/PFFM, covering the period June 1, 2017 – June 30, 2019; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWO

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$80,750.00 from Free Cash to FY2019 budget line item number 0100.0192.5815 (Public Buildings and Properties – Equipment) for the purpose of providing the Town’s matching share of a FEMA grant to purchase emergency generators for Town Hall and the Hilton Senior Center, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE THREE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$42,500.00 from Free Cash to FY2019 budget line item number 2159.0150.5100 (Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness Grant – Expenses) for the purpose of providing the Town’s matching share of a Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness grant for design and engineering costs of a project intended to relieve flooding conditions along Ferry Road and March Street, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE FOUR

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2019 budget line item number 0100.0413.5830.3078 (DPW Capital Outlay – Retrofit Street Lights) for the purpose of supplementing an appropriation approved under Article

5 of the October 22, 2018 Annual Fall town Meeting to retrofit the Town's street lights to energy efficient and long-lasting LED street lights, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.
ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FIVE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$52,000.00 from Free Cash to FY2019 budget line item number 0100.0210.5815 (Police Department – Capital Outlay - Equipment) for the purpose of purchasing and installing six new parking kiosks and related signage at Salisbury Beach, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$30,000.00 from Free Cash to the Other Post-Employment Benefits Trust Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$20,000.00 from Free Cash to the Compensated Absences Reserve Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$20,000.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to the Compensated Absences Reserve Fund; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ARTICLE TEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$10,000.00 from Free Cash to the Unemployment Compensation Fund to provide for unanticipated costs of funding reimbursements to the Commonwealth for unemployment compensation benefits under the provisions of MGL Chapter 151A; or to take any other action relative thereto.
ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE ELEVEN

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate the sum of \$910.91 from the Transportation Infrastructure Receipts Reserved for Appropriation Fund for the purpose of purchasing three bicycles with related accessories, to be used for work-related transportation needs of various town employees; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWELVE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$6,327.00 from FY2019 budget line item number 0101.0541.5815.3059 (Council on Aging – Phone System) to FY2019 budget line item number 0100.0145.5285 (Treasurer – Tax title) for the purpose of funding anticipated tax title expenses for the remainder of the fiscal year; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE THIRTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$125,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5307 (Water Enterprise Fund – Engineering) for the purpose of funding engineering and design costs for the replacement of the water main on Bridge Road from Friedenfels Road to Salisbury Square, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FOURTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$25,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5307 (Water Enterprise Fund – Engineering) for the purpose of funding a portion of a study to upgrade the water infrastructure on Railroad Avenue; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE FIFTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$25,000.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 6000.0440.5307 (Sewer Enterprise Fund – Engineering) for the purpose of funding a portion of a study to upgrade the sewer infrastructure on Railroad Avenue; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE SIXTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$120,000.00 from Sewer Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 Sewer Enterprise Fund budget line item number 6000.0440.5830 (Sewer Enterprise Fund – Capital Outlay – Infrastructure), such funds to supplement an appropriation approved under Article 10 of the October 22, 2018 Annual Fall Town Meeting, for the purpose of constructing a storage facility at the Town’s wastewater treatment facility, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE SEVENTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$55,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5830 (Water Enterprise Fund – Capital Outlay – Infrastructure) for the purpose of funding the replacement of water hydrants, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE EIGHTEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$250,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5830 (Water Enterprise Fund – Capital Outlay – Infrastructure) for the purpose of funding the replacement of water mains, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE NINETEEN

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$45,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5830 (Water Enterprise Fund – Capital Outlay – Infrastructure) for the purpose of funding the replacement of gate valves, including all incidental and related costs; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWENTY

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$40,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5278 (Water Enterprise Fund – Purchase of Services – Contracted Maintenance and Repairs) for the purpose of performing inspections of the North End Boulevard and Beach Road water tanks; or to take any other action relative thereto.

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWENTY-ONE

To see if the Town will vote to transfer the sum of \$95,000.00 from Water Enterprise Fund Retained Earnings to FY2019 budget line item number 7000.0450.5278 (Water Enterprise Fund – Water Systems Maintenance and Repairs) for the purpose of replacing a right angle drive motor with a generator at Well #7; or to take any other action relative thereto

ON PETITION OF THE TOWN MANAGER

ARTICLE TWENTY-TWO

To take any other action that may be lawfully taken at this meeting.

And you are hereby directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies in at least ten (10) public places in Town over two consecutive Sundays before the time of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon, to the Town Clerk at the time and place of said meeting.




