1. New Public Hearing

Case No. 21-27 Petition for Relief – Variance to request relief from the front and side yard setbacks in order to reposition existing structure on the property.

Address: 93 Railroad Ave

Map: 32, Lot: 198

Applicant(s): John Burns

Michelle Blanchette represents the applicant. The applicant is requesting a variance for relief from the front and side yard setbacks in order to raise and reposition existing structure on the property. Also representing the applicant is Ed Dixon, Engineer from Hancock Associates. Relocating the structure will have the following impact in regards to setbacks: front from -0.19' to +1' where 20' is required, right side from 1.76' to 2' where 10' is required, the left side non-conformity of 8.67' will be corrected to 10.8' where 10' is required. Rear setback remains conforming.

MOTION: Mr. Fitzwater makes a motion to approve the request for a variance for Case No. 21-27 at 93 Railroad Ave based on the shape of the lot. Mr. Dana seconds the motion.
